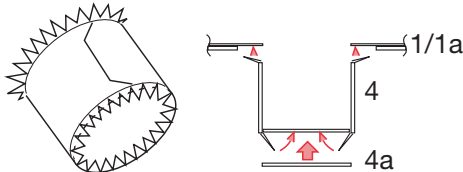


## Instruction for the Carbon Freezing Chamber: 3D Scenery for Star Wars Miniatures

A) Print files carbon1-4 on heavy duty paper (best  $>150 \text{ g/cm}^2$ ). Cut out all parts and order by number. Parts 1a, 5a and 7a must be cut out of stiff card board. Use the print out (carbon4) as stencil and glue the card board bits onto the backside of parts 1, 5 and 7, respectively. The positions are marked by the dotted lines.

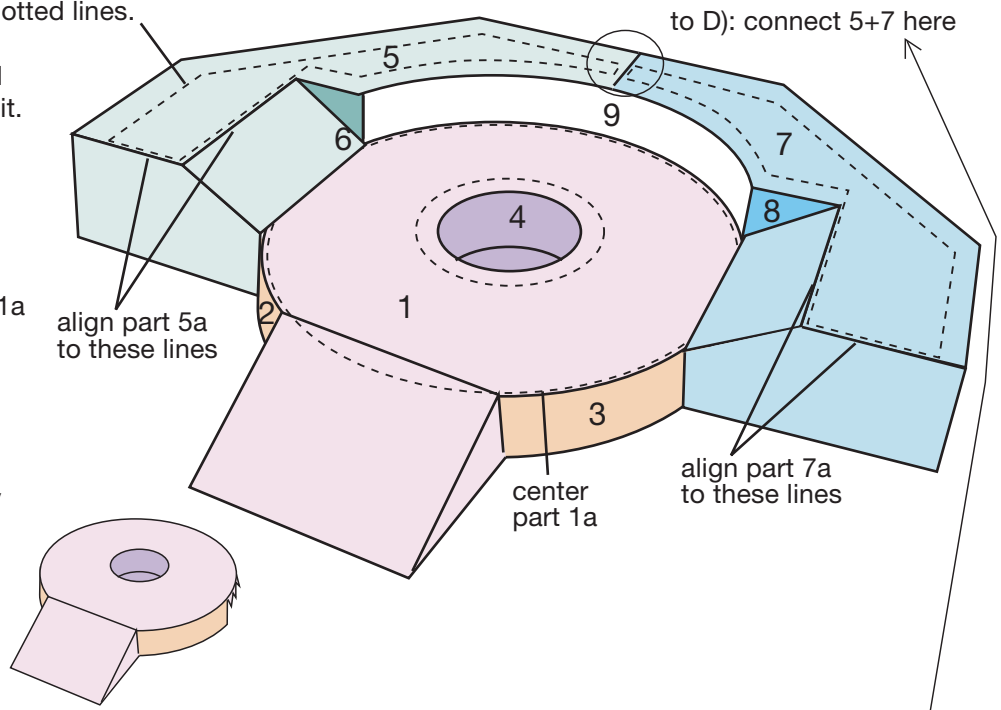
B) Fold part 1 like the pink shaded area shows and glue parts 2+3 to it.

C) Fold part 4 to a cup shape, of which the orange circle is the bottom.



Fix from underneath with part 4a, then glue to part 1 as indicated by the violet shaded area.

This is what you have now: the center part. You can use this separately by covering the back hole with part 10.

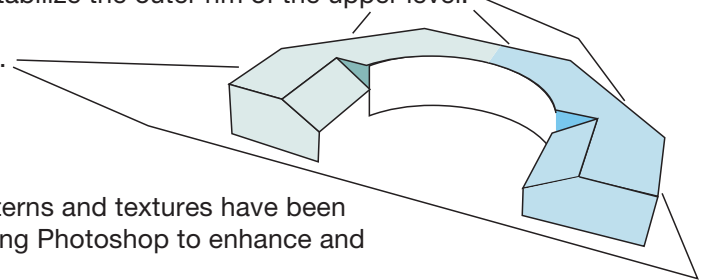


D) Fold parts 5 and 7 as shown by the green and blue shaded areas. Insert parts 6 and 8 to fix the stairs at their right angle. Then connect parts 5 and 7 at their back. Place the object above the center part to adjust, then glue on the final part 9. You can then either glue the upper level to the center part or leave it separate.

E) Use 3 Carbon chamber walls and 2 Octagon links to stabilize the outer rim of the upper level.

Fill in the remaining holes with two pieces of cut up walls.

F) Build the accessories and props of files carbon5+6 to finalize the model.

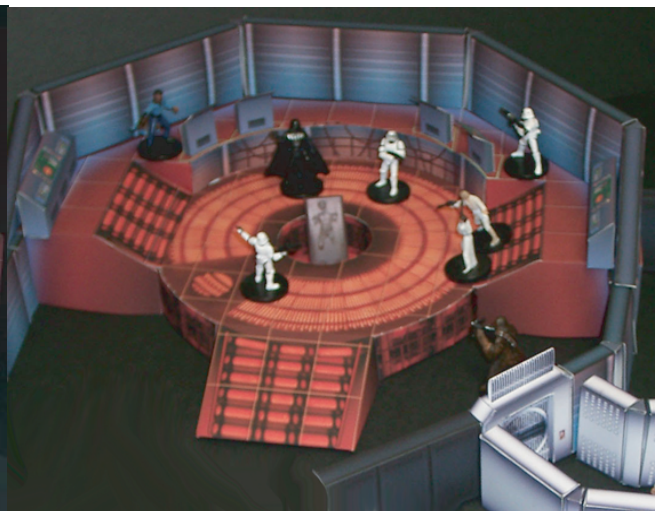
